

## **Judging Procedures**

- Classes will be Judged by a panel of seven Judges, rotated in groups of six throughout the classes.
- In the classes, the number of points will be divided by the number of judges to give a score out of 100 for the horse. The highest and lowest points will be noted but not counted in the score.

## **Methods of Judging and Scale of Points**

Points from 1 to 20 will be awarded by each Judge for 5 topics. Half points are allowed.

Type, Head and Neck, Body and Topline, Legs, Movement.

## **Judging of Championships:**

- Championships will be Judged by the panel of all Judges.
- The first, second and third placed horses in each class will qualify for the finals leading to the selection of the gold, silver and bronze medallists.
- Championships will be judged according to the Rules for Ties and Championships listed in the “Show Schedule”. New method ‘C’ will be followed

## **Championships and Medals:**

- Championship A: Qatar International Straight Egyptian Filly 2016 Gold Medallist  
+ Qatar International Straight Egyptian Filly, Silver Medallist + Qatar International Straight Egyptian Filly, Bronze Medallist  
The first, second and third placed Fillies in classes 1, 2 and 3 will qualify.
- Championship B: Qatar International Straight Egyptian Colt 2016 Gold Medallist  
+ Qatar International Straight Egyptian Colt, Silver Medallist + Qatar International Straight Egyptian Colt, Bronze Medallist  
The first, second and third placed Colts in classes 4, 5 and 6 will qualify.
- Championship C: Qatar International Straight Egyptian Mare 2016 Gold Medallist  
+ Qatar International Straight Egyptian Mare, Silver Medallist + Qatar International Straight Egyptian Mare, Bronze Medallist  
The first, second and third placed Mares in classes 7, 8 and 9 will qualify.
- Championship D: Qatar International Straight Egyptian Stallion 2016 Gold Medallist  
+ Qatar International Straight Egyptian Horse, Silver Medallist + Qatar International Straight Egyptian Horse, Bronze Medallist  
The first, second and third placed Stallions in classes 10, 11 and 12 will qualify.

## **Prizes in kind and Prize Money**

### **Prizes in kind:**

- The top five placed horses will receive rosettes for each place respectively.
- The top five placed horses will receive plaques for each place respectively.

### **Prize Money:**

- The top five placed horses will receive:
  - First: QR 30,000
  - Second: QR 25,000
  - Third: QR 20,000
  - Fourth: QR 8,000
  - Fifth: QR 7,000

A total of QR 90,000 for each class

- Gold, silver and bronze medallists will receive the following:
  - Champion colts and fillies will receive rosettes for gold, silver and bronze as well as plaques and prize money as follows:
    - Gold: QR 90,000
    - Silver: QR 70,000
    - Bronze: QR 50,000
  - Mares and stallions will receive rosettes for gold, silver and bronze as well as horse plaques and prize money as follows:
    - Gold: QR 150,000
    - Silver: QR 90,000
    - Bronze: QR 60,000
