

Purebred Straight Egyptian Arabian Horse Show for Non-Sheikh
Individual General Conditions

- Only purebred straight Egyptian Arabian horses, which appear in a register listed by the World Arabian Horse Organisation (WAHO) as acceptable, are eligible.
- Any Qatari individual owner is eligible to participate in this Show.
- Major farms and studs owned by Sheikhs are ineligible for this Show.
- Horses whose ownership has been transferred during or before the Show, during the season, are ineligible and the ownership must be by the owner himself.
- Prize in kind and prize money will be offered to the first five placed horses in each class.
- Prize in kind and prize money will be offered to the winners of the Gold Champion, the Silver Champion and the Bronze Champion titles, for fillies, colts, mares and stallions.
- There is no compensation for horse transport costs.
- The Organising Committee will not be responsible for any injuries or incidents that may happen to participants, trainers or grooms.
- Horse tack and equipment shall be provided by the participating horse owners.
- Only two persons, as a maximum, are allowed to be with each participating horse in the horse preparation area.
- It is strictly prohibited to converse with the Disciplinary Committee during the Show. In case of any objection to a decision etc., all shall follow the instructions of European Conference of Arab Horse Organisations (ECAHO) by filing an objection and payment of the established related fee of € 200.00 (Euros Two Hundred) or its equivalent in Qatar Riyals. The Disciplinary Committee shall, then, consider such objection and inform the respective horse owner of their decision.
- In the event of violating the QREC instructions, by conversing with the Disciplinary Committee, the Organising Committee will be entitled to suspend the respective horse owner or trainer from participating in the horse shows organised by QREC, depending on the respective violation.
- This Show is subject to the Constitution and RULES of the European Conference of ECAHO although it is not ECAHO affiliated.

- Entries are open with effect from 20 December 2016 to 27 December 2016. The entry fee is QR 500.00 (Qatar Riyals Five Hundred) per horse in any class.
- Training shall be outside QREC premises for owners wishing to have their horses trained by QREC trainers. This shall be against a fee of QR 2,000.00 (Qatar Riyals Two Thousand) per horse to be paid to QREC.
- Training fees shall be for this Show only and for duration with effect from the date when the respective owner pays the established fees for training his horse(s) and up to the date of the Show.
