

General Conditions

- Only purebred straight Egyptian Arabian horses, registered in any WAHO recognized stud book by the closing date of entries are eligible to participate.
- If the number of horse entries in any class is more than 16 horses, the respective class may be sub-divided and the horse age categories may be re-arranged in order to give every class the appropriate balance.
- If the number of horse entries in any class is less than five horses, the respective class will be combined and the Organising Committee (OC), as it deems appropriate for the public interest, will be entitled to cancel a class which has a number of horses less than the allowed number.
- There is no compensation for horse transport costs.
- OC is not responsible for any injuries or incidents that may happen to participants, trainers or grooms.
- Horse tack and equipment shall be provided by the participating horse owners.
- Each handler at the Show must have an exhibitor licence issued by ECAHO; otherwise they will not be allowed to take part at the Show.
- Handler numbers will be distributed on the day of the Show (An hour or two prior to exhibiting).
- OC will provide discounts at hotels located near the venue. Participants may liaise directly with such hotels. List of hotels and contacts will be provided soon.
- OC will provide accommodation only for the grooms accompanying the horses.
- OC will provide stabling for the participating horses from 08 to 12 February, 2017.
- Horse owners and trainers will be held responsible for non-compliance with ECAHO Rules for Conduct of Shows, including the Rules from 29 to 45 thereof.
- Non-compliance with such rules will be reported to the Standing Disciplinary Committee that is empowered to take appropriate decisions in accordance with the rules of standing disciplinary committees.
